


# Elizabeth Anna



## About Our CSA

For the last 28 years, community supported agriculture (CSA) has become a popular way for consumers to buy local, seasonal, organic foods from farmers in their own region in the USA. Joining a CSA is a great way to get the freshest and healthiest foods for your family as well as support local organic farmers.

Elizabeth Anna's owns and operates an urban farm and we go a step further by partnering with other select local organic farmers in the area so we can bring our clients a greater selection of produce, all-natural Angus beef, free range poultry, and free range eggs.

### **Here is how it works:**

We have your box of fresh, locally grown, organic, non-GMO produce available for you to pick up at our urban farm and garden store every week on Friday, from 12pm until 5pm, and Saturday, from 9am until 5pm. Customers can enjoy access to these delicious and healthy foods for as long as they like. If they ever want to cancel or put deliveries on hold the can do so easily.

### **How much does our CSA cost?**

There are two great choices available:

- \$35.00 for a Sprout size, that feeds approximately 1 to 3 people weekly.
- \$55.00 for a Grande size, that feeds approximately 3 to 5 people weekly.

An annual membership fee of \$50.00 dollars is charged initially and automatically recharged annually from your sign-up date, as well as a one-time rental charge of \$12.00 for the produce basket provided. If you lose the basket or bag, or damage the basket, another one can be purchased for \$10.00.

Unlike all other CSA we allow weekly payments, weekly changes, two-day pick-up, time off for vacations, your garden's surplus, family changes, etc. We also have an every-other-week pick-up option for those who do not eat lots of veggies. We provide many non-traditional CSA concessions so that you can enjoy the best local, organic, sustainable, full of variety, year-round CSA, possible.

### **CSA Policies:**

- Friday Pick-ups are from 12pm until 5pm
- Saturday pick-ups are from 9am until 5pm
- If you are unable to pickup your basket and fail to notify us, we must auto-bill you the price of your basket. This is to protect everyone in the CSA from an increase in price due

to wasted product.

- If you are unable to pickup your basket, you MUST contact us before 12pm on the Tuesday before your pickup.
  1. Arrange for a pick-up the Tuesday after between the hours of 9am to 2pm.
  2. Donate your basket (rest assured your basket will not be wasted!).
  3. Delivery within a 20 mile radius of Fort Worth is \$15.00.

**\*\*\*REMEMBER\*\*\***

**If we do not hear from you on Saturday before 5pm, you will be charged for your basket and the food will be donated. All auto-billing is ran as a credit card payment. This has a 3% convenience fee. To avoid this fee you must pay debit, cash or check.**
